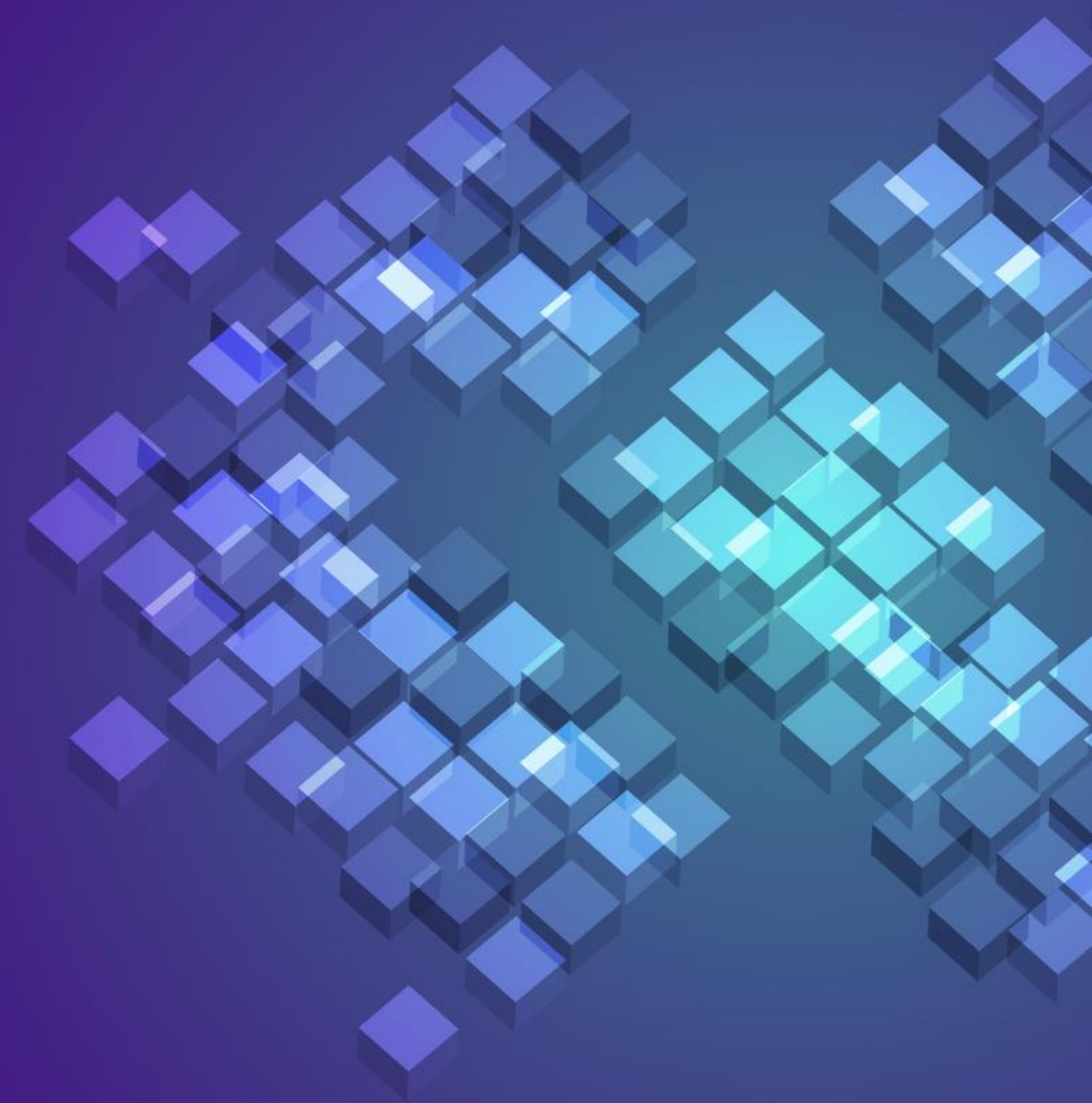

SDMX Hackathon 2023



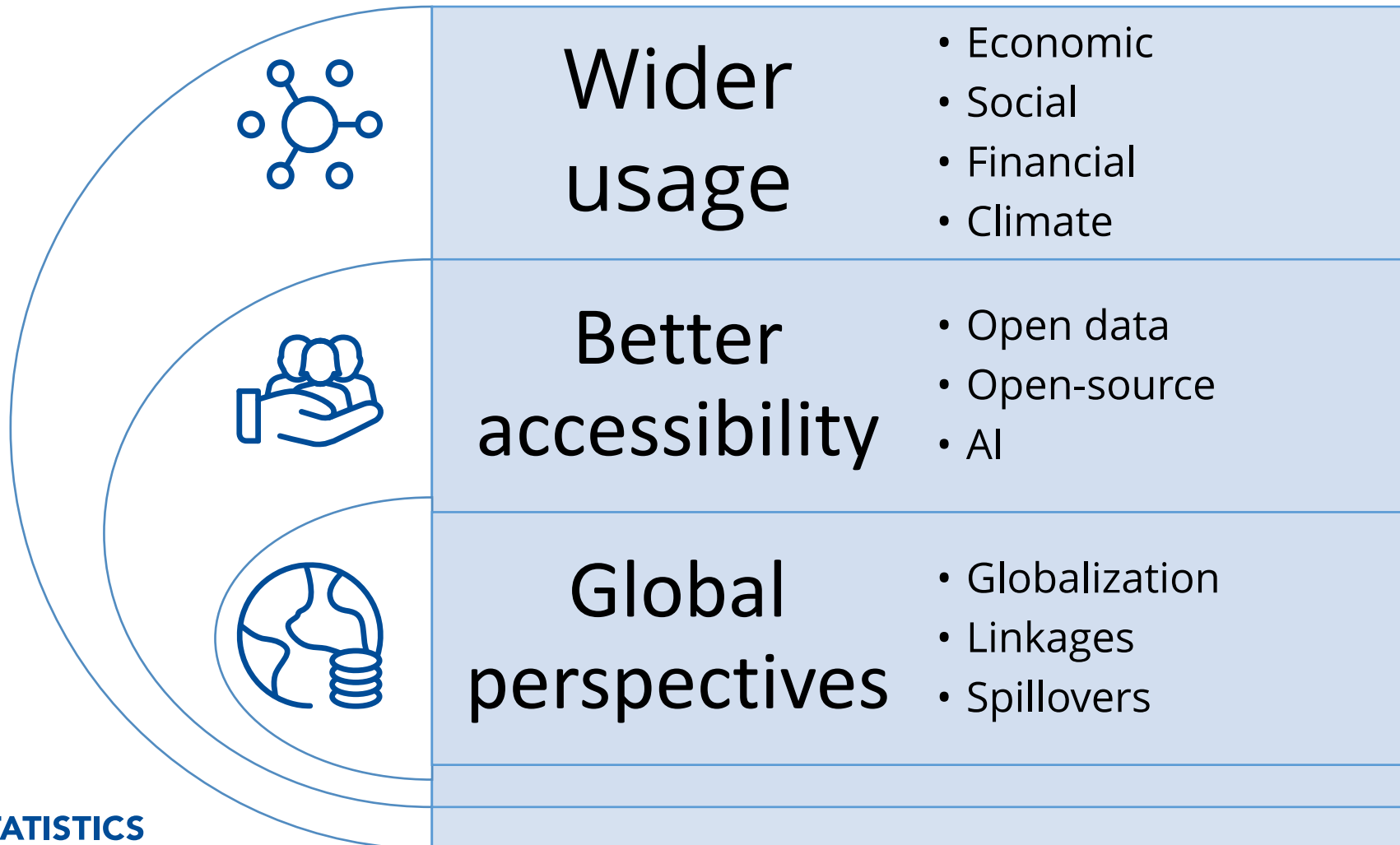
- A global first for the SDMX Community launched on July 6, 2023, to develop an Open Source SDMX Dashboard.
- 16 teams of developers, statisticians, and data experts registered to compete for a prize of 10,000 Swiss Francs, a certificate and wall plaque.
- Two winning teams:
 - **BIS team:** Cristina Leonte, Pietro Patelli, Stephan Probst, and Olivier Sirello
 - **Pacific Community team:** Thomas Tilak and Stan Ozier

Empowering Data Communities

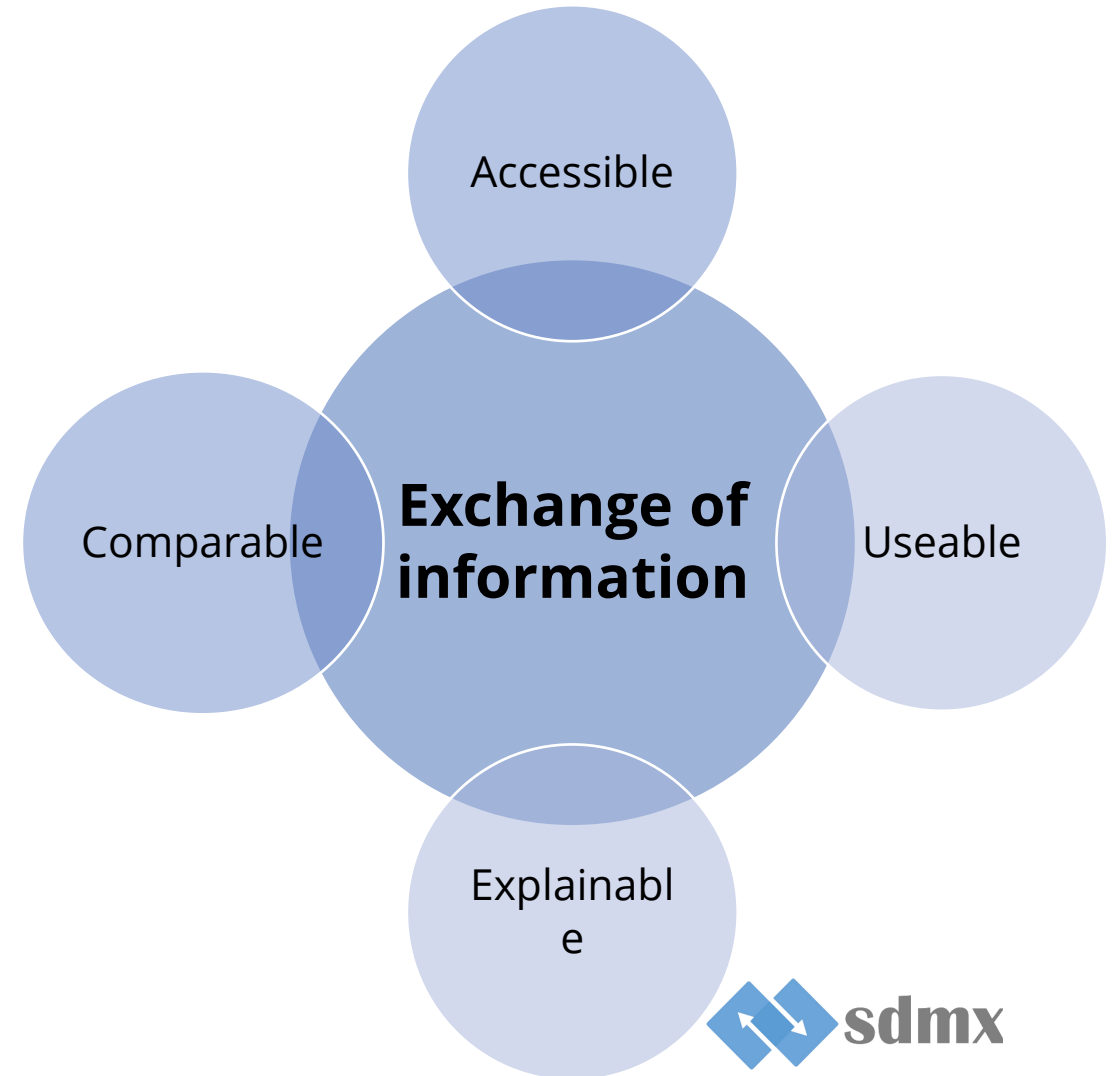
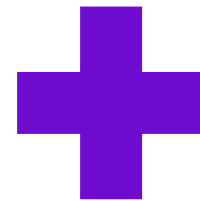


- The theme of the 2023 conference is ***Empowering Data Communities*** and will explore how SDMX tools and technologies can be leveraged to enhance collaboration and knowledge sharing.
- The conference will feature new use cases, guidelines, and open-source tools to facilitate exchange of data and metadata using SDMX.
- Use of SDMX is also expanding towards non-traditional users, such as private sector and academia, creating inter-linkages between a variety of “data communities”.

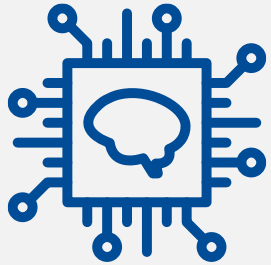

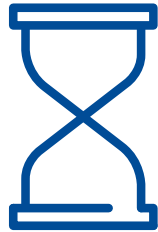
Benefits of SDMX

Supports modernization



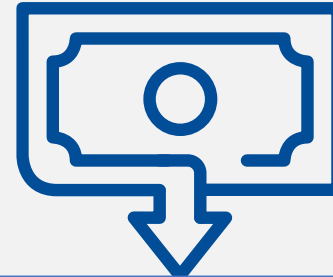
Common tools, processes, and language support industrialization of statistics

Open source, community sharing, and automation of validation and web-services

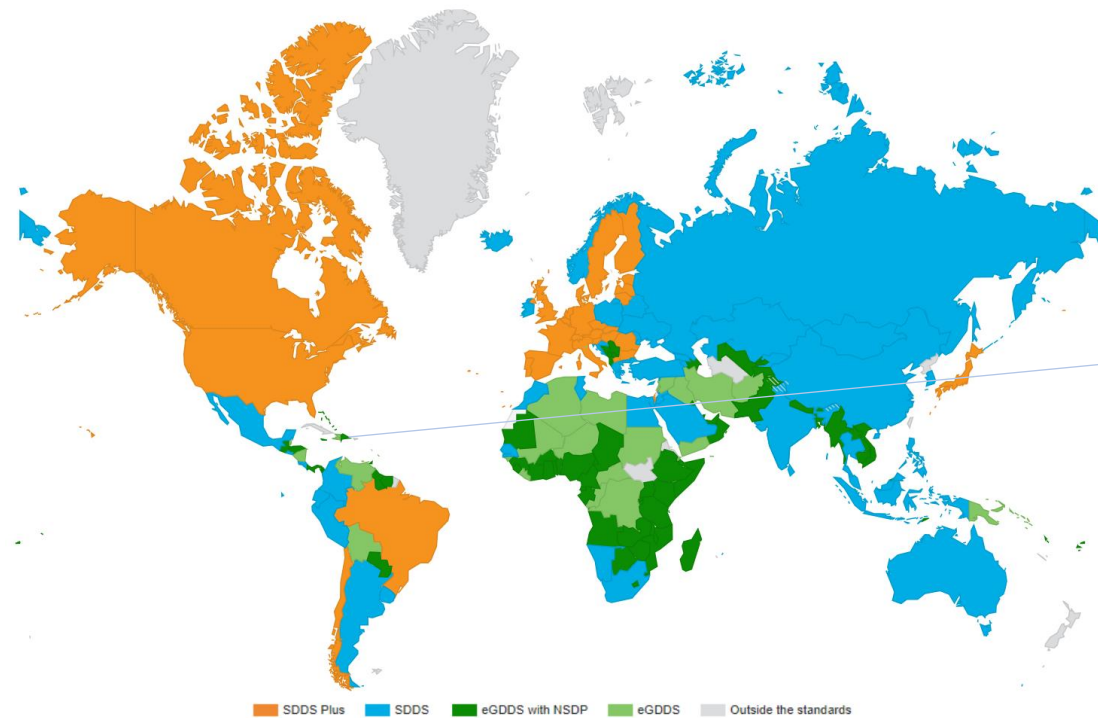
Provides access to a global community

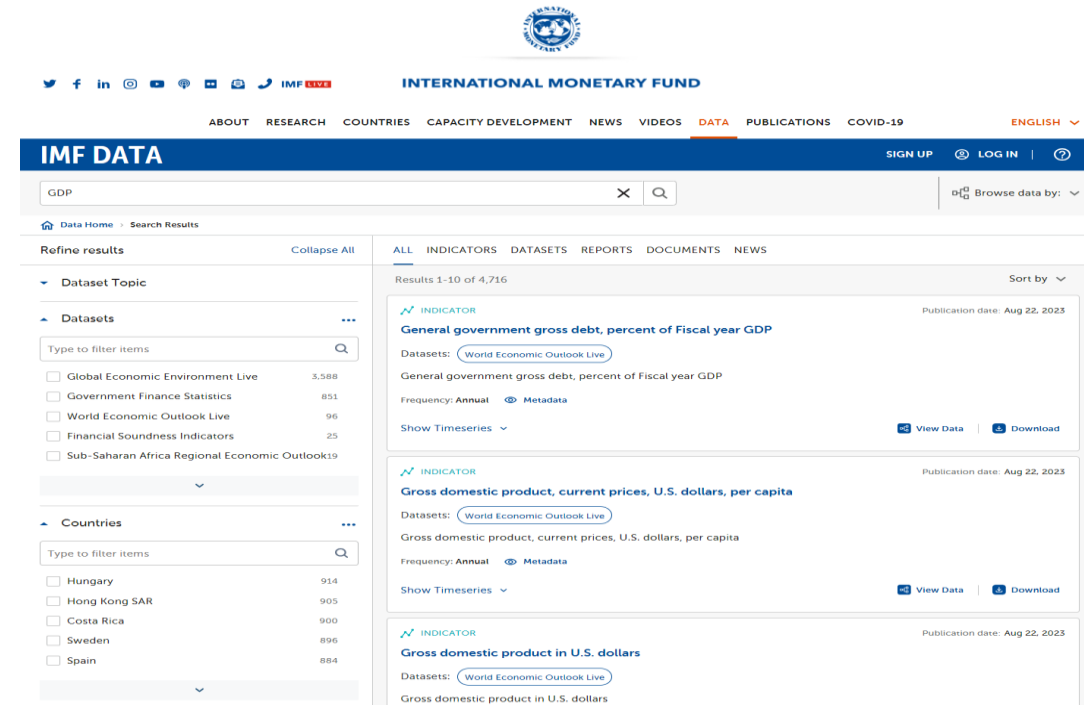
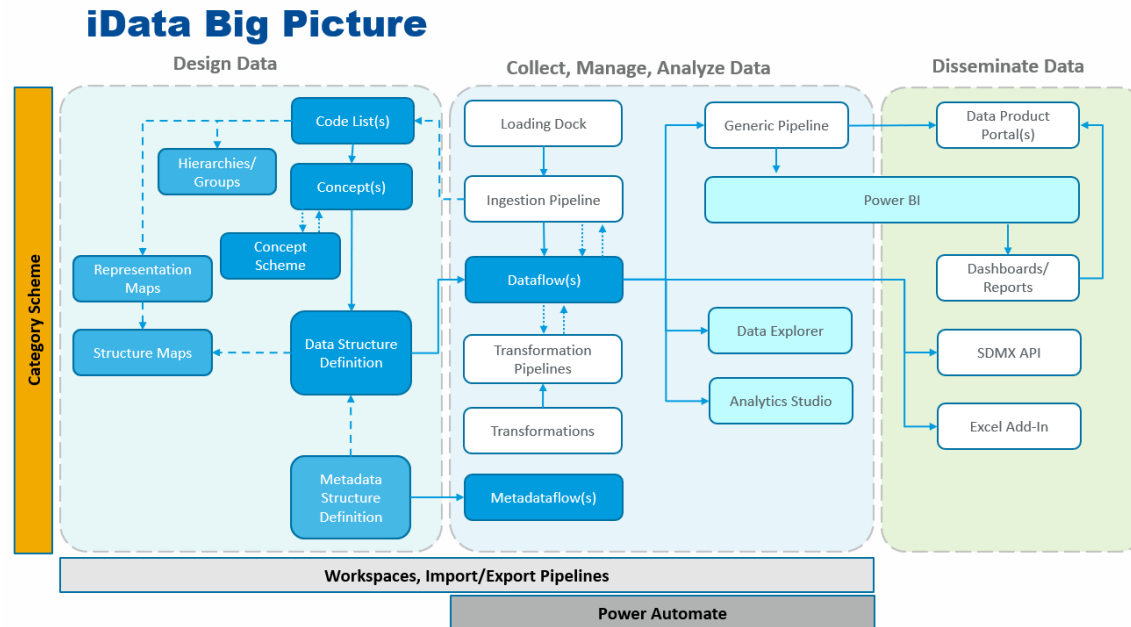
